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2) Eligibility Criteria:

- a) Candidates should have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or should complete the age as on 31st December of the year of admission. Upper Age Limit 25Years.
- b) Candidates must have passed in H.Sc., (or) its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination mentioned above for unreserved candidates and 40% marks in respect of SC/ ST/OBC Classes.
- c) Candidates should obtained the eligible Percentile score in the NEET (UG) 2019 conducted by the NTA, New Delhi.

- a) Candidate who have been allotted through centralized counseling by the AACCC of Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi for admission to **BHMS** Programme in the Deemed to be University for the academic year 2019-20, are advised to report and complete the admission process within the date and time specified in the "Allotment Letter" issued by the AACCC.

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- b) The candidate should report along with **original certificates and Demand Draft** for the prescribed tuition fee and other fees or UTR Number for **Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS** as specified herein below.
- c) i) Candidate without original certificates / documents shall **not** be allowed to take admission in the allotted Homoeopathic Medical College.
ii) Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute/ College / University and come for admission with a certificate stating that "their original certificates are deposited with the Institute / College / University" will not be allowed to take admission in allotted Homoeopathic Medical College.
- d) Every student shall pay the tuition fee and other fee, as prescribed by the University, within the due date notified.
- e) Part payment of tuition fee and other fee are not permitted.
- f) No extension of time either for payment of fee or submission of original certificates will be entertained under any circumstances.
- g) At the time of admission, candidate should sign declaration / undertakings declaring that they shall abide by the rules and regulations of the University including Anti-Ragging regulations of the UGC/ CCH /

AYUSH and observe good conduct and behavior and that they are bound by the University rules on payment of fees / refund of fees.

5) MODE OF PAYMENT OF FEE:

a) TUITION FEE & OTHER FEE:

6) IMPORTANT NOTE:

- a) Candidates are advised to check the website of the **AYUSH Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC)** Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India, New Delhi website: www.aacc.gov.in and College website: www.vmhmc.edu.in from time to time.
- b) **Allotment letter given by the AYUSH Admissions Central Counseling Committee for admission is subject to fulfillment of all eligibility criteria prescribed by the CCH and medical fitness of the candidates.** Those who do not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and not found medically fit, will not be admitted to the course of study to which they are allotted by the AACCC. If it is found at a later stage, that the candidate has given false information / forged certificates or concealed material information, his/her admission will be cancelled without any notice.
- c) Students will be governed by all the University rules including rules for refund of fee, disciplinary rules and hostel rules etc.
- d) All the disputes/arbitration arising in the interpretation and implementation of the provisions in this prospectus will be referred to the Vice-Chancellor, Vinayaka Mission’s Research Foundation (Deemed to be

University) and Vice-Chancellor's decision shall be final and binding.

7) REFUND POLICY:
