




NDLI








GINKGO BILOBA - A LIVING FOSSIL

Abstract

Ginkgo biloba, commonly called the maiden hair tree, has been grown in China and Japan since ancient times. The tree is popular because it is resistant to disease and draught, and partly also because it is able to tolerate the smoke and fumes of city. The tree is considered to be a "living fossil," meaning that it has continued to survive even after major extinction events. The therapeutic properties of the ginkgo plant are said to include treatment for blood disorders and memory problems, enhancement of cardiovascular function and to improve eye health.

Keywords: Gingko biloba, health benefits, homoeopathic therapeutics

Introduction

Ginkgo biloba, commonly known as ginkgo or gingko is a species of tree native to China. The tree was cultivated early in human history and remains commonly planted. The ginkgo has distinct leaves. The fan shaped leaves of Ginkgo are flat and irregularly notched. Gingko leaf extract is commonly used as a dietary supplement, but there is no scientific evidence that it supports human health or is effective against any disease

Phytochemicals

Gingko contains high levels of flavonoids and terpenoids, antioxidants that provide protection against oxidative cell damage from harmful free radicals.

Biological effects of Ginkgo: Ginkgo biloba purported biological effects include: scavenging free radical; lowering oxidative stress; reducing neural damages,





reducing platelets aggregation; anti-inflammation; anti-tumor activities; and anti-aging.

Homoeopathic uses

Clinical indications

Absent-minded, Asthma, Alzheimer's disease, Attention weak, Concentration, poor, Dyslexia, Influenza, Memory, weak, Mental weakness, Mumps, Laryngitis, Senility, Tonsillitis.

Mind: Mentally weak and exhausted. Poor concentration. Dullness of mind. and inability to solve mental tasks. Senility and Alzheimer's disease. Mental work is an effort to carry out. Irrational fears with rapid speech. Nebulous condition with the impression of unreality. Needs to criticize others and himself. Suppressed anger with desire to tear up something.

Head: Frontal headache. Heaviness in the frontal region. Pain above the left orbital nerve. Vertigo. Eyeballs painful, especially on looking up and to the right. Sensation of impaired vision with a veil in front of the eyes. Ophthalmic migraine. Buzzing noises in ears. Dry Mouth. Tongue yellow towards the root. Swallowing difficult with scraping sensation in the pharynx.

Throat: Pharyngitis. Congestion of the parotid glands. Rising pain along the line of the lower maxilla. Prickling pains in the left tonsil with need to clear the throat regularly.

Extremities: General cramps and writer's cramp. Clenching of the right hand with trembling. Legs feel like jelly, feet feel icy. Pains at the nape of the neck, at the tips of the scapulae.

Lungs: Difficult expectoration of thick sputum. Dyspnoea. Laryngitis. Laryngeal irritation with cough. Asthma.

Male: Urethral discharge of yellowish pus. Diminished sex drive.

Female: Premature menses. Pre-menstrual lumbar pains. Leucorrhea.

Stomach & Abdomen: Sensation of emptiness in the stomach. Heaviness and burning in the stomach. Dyspepsia Abdomen tense and swollen. Colic, followed by diarrhea-like stools. Intestinal diseases caused by worms. Pain in the region of the bladder and loins. Diarrhea-like stools. Worms. Sensation of heat in the anus.

Skin: Transient Small-pox like eruption. Vesicular, burning, itching eruption. Eczema.

Sleep: Sleep heavy with nightmares. Dreams of corpses. Insomnia between 2 a.m. and 3 a.m.

Modalities: Better from the heat, rest. Worse from cold, walking, drinking, looking up and to the right, around 2 a.m.- 3 a.m. Worse right side.

Conclusion: In the past decades, interest by the general public in the use of herbal dietary supplements has risen exponentially. Ginkgo biloba is an herb used to treat

altitude sickness (prevention), cerebral vascular insufficiency, cognitive disorders, dementia, dizziness/vertigo, intermittent claudication, macular degeneration/glaucoma, memory loss, premenstrual syndrome, SSRI-induced sexual dysfunction, and as a vasodilator.

A CASE OF POLYCYSTIC OVARIAN SYNDROME

Homoeopaths always enjoy a privilege of being a family doctor. One such incident happened to me. One of my chronic female patient whom I cured few months ago brought her daughter who was working in IT at Bangalore and said that she was about to get married soon with a relative boy. I thought she came to me for an invitation, but she followed, "Sir, I'm in a great worry now". I exclaimed at her, "You should be happy though". However, she told that her daughter is having an irregular menses since few years and consulted several doctors and had been diagnosed as having polycystic ovarian disease. Following is the case history.

CHIEF COMPLAINT: Date of Case taking: 12-11-12

- 1. Irregular menses since 5 years: delayed for 3-6 months; appears only on taking allopathic tablets. Profuse, lasts for 20 days. Dark red clots, No pain. LMP: 29-10-12 spots present; Again flow started on 5-11-12, Profuse flow present till now for 5 days. Menarche: 12 years.
- 2. Headache since 3 years: Temples <Right, Occiput. Occurs daily at night. A/F: Loss of sleep. Pain: < Watching computer, TV, Head bath, Cold exposure, Night2+; > After sleep
- 3. Recurrent H/o. Throat Pain: A/F. Drinking Cold water, Sensation of Mucus in throat. Hoarseness of voice <on waking at morning. Pain < Swallowing, Cold food & drinks, > Warm food & drinks

4. Leucorrhoea: Whitish, Semi-solid; Itching; Offensive; < Physical exertion

Past History: No H/o any major illness in the past.

Family History: No H/o any major illness among family members.

Physical Generals:

Appetite/Thirst/Stool/Urine/Sweat: Normal

Sleep: Normal, 10pm-7am.

Dreams of being chased (in Childhood); of unknown persons coming home2+, targeting and raping her; of being murdered; of Gods

Thermal: Chilly patient

Craving: Chocolates 3+, Sweets 2+, Ice cream

Life Space Investigation:

- Patient belongs to Upper-class family. She is the Elder daughter. Has one younger sister. Father is a Government official; Mother is a teacher in Reputed Higher Secondary School at Salem.
- Since her Childhood, Mother always insists her to get high marks. She got first rank in school always. She tries at her extreme and achieves the rank every time. She was the Class and School Topper
- She wants to be the first in everything and wants to be rewarded always. From childhood finishes her works in prompt timings. She gets disturbed if anyone finds fault with her works.
- Her mother scolds a lot for every work. She was much affected by her parents' scolding. She used to weep a lot due to her scolding. She also said, "Whatever my sister does she gets a good name from my parents, but I am not".
- Since Childhood, she has fear of animals.



Reasons for remedy selection:

Craving for Chocolate , Fear of animals (Vithoulkas) , Dreams of being pursued by someone, Discharges Thick, Acrid, Causations: Night-watching , Passionate people who over-extend themselves , Aversion to reprimand or contradiction, Fastidious , Encysted tumors: cyst in ovaries, Headache: esp. Right Temples, Sensation of Lump in the throat < empty swallowing; Hoarseness

Prescription: 12-11-12: Carcinosin. 200/ 1 dose in 100ml Aqua/10 succussions-10 drops-OD.

Follow Up:

30-12-12 - Menses stopped on 20-11-12. Dreams stopped. Leucorrhoea still present. Headache occurs on & off - R 1. Continue drops , 2. SL-OD for 1 month.

26-01-13 - LMP: Menses Not yet appeared. Headache once occurred severely. R 1. Continue drops 2. SL-OD for 1 month.

15-03-13 - LMP: 05-01-13. Flow still present, profuse & last for 15 to 20 days, Headache on & off; Leucorrhoea present - R 1. Continue drops 2. SL-OD for 1 month.

23-05-13 - LMP: 20-5-13. Profuse flow but no clots present now. Headache not appeared later. Dreams not recurred. R 1. Continue drops 2. SL-OD for 1 month.

16-08-13 - LMP: 10-08-13 present till date. Profuse flow. No Clots. This time menses occurred once in 2 months. Leucorrhoea only on severe exertion. R 1. Continue drops 2. SL-OD for 1 month.

31-10-13 - LMP: 30-10-13 started yesterday. Normal flow. No H/o Leucorrhoea. R 1. Continue drops 2. SLOD for 1 month.

28-02-14 - Menses once in 45 days now. But profuse. C/o. Throat pain on & off for 1 month. R 1. Continue drops 2. SL-OD for 1 month.

19-06-14 - Menses absent suddenly since 2 months. C/o. Profuse leucorrhoea, itching and burning pains. A/F: Patient has been compared by her future in-laws with her sister-in-law for dowry. Marriage not yet done but this created a stress in her mind since she is being compared R 1. Carcinosin.1M/1dose in 100 ml Aqua-10 strokes – 10 drops – OD 2. SL–OD for 1 month


05-08-14 - Menses appeared on 30-06-14. Flow profuse and clotted. Throat pain on & off after taking cold food and drinks. R 1. Continue drops 2. SL-OD for 1 month

09-11-14 - Menses appeared on 29-08-14, 30-09-14 & 25-10-14. Flow lasted for 1 week every time with pain. Leucorrhoea present, watery & scanty. Advised for USG scan. R 1. Continue drops 2. SL-OD for 1 month

30-11-14 - USG taken. Normal study. LMP 28-11-14. Flow normal. Medicine stopped

Discussion:

The case was followed for a period of about two years with daily administration of water dose medicine. In between the follow up visits, timely adjustments of the water doses of the same medicine according to the trouble. At some times, acute remedies were also given according to the exciting cause. Later, her constitutional remedy was followed back and continued further. Once potency change was done and it brought on a rapid improvement. Now patient got married on January 2015 and she is having a male child now. This case had taught another lesson, homoeopathy could do wonders where there is no scope for allopathy. The USG scan reports at the beginning of treatment and at the end of treatment are attached for reference.
