1. PREAMBLE:

Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (VMRF (DU)) had its inception in the year 1981 with the establishment of the Thirumuruga Kirupananda Variyar Thavathiru Sundara Swamigal (TKVTSS) Medical Educational and Charitable Trust. In 1982, the Founder-Chairman, Dr. A Shanmugasundaram instituted the Vinayaka Mission's College of Pharmacy in Salem, the pioneer institution of Vinayaka Missions. In the year 2001 the "Deemed to be University" status was conferred on Vinayaka Missions by The Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India, with the recommendations of the UGC Under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 as an acknowledgement of its excellence, satisfaction of the highest level of academic standards and best infrastructural facilities provided to achieve pre-eminence in education and by virtue of this recognition Vinayaka Missions transcended to become Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (VMRF) as the 48th University in India. It has 13 colleges and 9 Schools offering higher Education and training in Medical, Dental, Homoeopathy, Nursing, Pharmacy, Engineering and Technology, Management, Architecture, Law and Arts & Science in four locations in Salem, Kancheepuram District, Pondicherry & Karaikal. All the Programmes offered by VMRF (DU) are approved by respective statutory bodies. VMRF (DU) is ranked in 101-150th band in NIRF under University Category and it is also NAAC accredited.

The University has more than 32 lakhs sqft of buildings at various campuses with state of art facilities. With many faculties within the University, It focuses in Interdisciplinary and Multi-Disciplinary Research as a main forte. The Medical colleges in Salem, Pondicherry and Karaikkal with a collective strength of 2000 beds are serving the rural population tirelessly with their healthcare activities. More than 30 villages have been adopted for the medical care and other health services. Satellite medical centres have been setup to serve the village peoples. Virology Research Labs have been setup in all three medical colleges with RT-PCR testing centres approved by the respective Governments for testing Covid SARS. All these labs are accredited by NABL. Vinayaka Missions Homeopathy College and Hospital have been accredited by NABH. Both medical colleges in Karaikkal and Pondicherry have been accredited by NABH at the entry level.

There are 46 Research centres / Laboratories in the University covering the thrust areas which include Biochemistry, Microbiology, Food Science and Technology, Virology, Alternative Energy, Environment, Pharmacy and Biotechnology, Biomedical Engineering, Artificial Intelligence, Internet of Things. Two Engineering colleges in Salem and Kancheepuram District have got MSME recognized Business Incubation centres which promote Entrepreneurial activities and startups.

WHEREAS, Sarada Krishna Homoeopathy Medical College functioning since 2000 in the mission of providing value based research oriented homoeopathy education. The institution has internalised quality culture in all its endeavours. The institution has been consciously consistently, improving its performance towards promotion of its holistic academic excellence. The institution has been providing UG Education for 100 students since 2000 and MID (Hom.) in 5 specialities for 30 students from 2010 and Ph.D in all PG specialities from 2018. The institution has commendable achievements in academic as well as extracurricular activities.

The speciality of training provided in the institution extends beyond curriculum with provisions for value added, subject related certificate courses, capacity building with the attitude for individual students to develop as promising physicians. The institution has hundred bedded NABH accredited college hospital, separate research facilitation centre, all sophisticated equipments and incubation centre, world class simulation lab, separate yoga centre, separate hostel for ladies and gents, world class library with separate sections for Post Graduates and Researchers. The institution has tie-up with National Agencies like CCRH and modern medical institutions of reputation for providing research and clinical training. For promotion of SWAYAM NPTEL courses, the institution has local chapter approved by IIT, Chennai. Apart from recognition of central and state government agencies, the institution is accredited with NAAC, NABH in participation in NIRF and registered with CDSCO for ethical committee. The institution has secured awards and recognition for participation in extension activities. The institution extends its medical service to all parts of the district and beyond through its 26 peripheral health centres, conduct regular health surveys, medical camps, awareness and preventive camps in collaboration with governmental and non-governmental agencies through the activities of community medicine department, NSS, YRC, RRC.

The institution continuously participates in village development programmes through programs of the government of India like UBA, Swasthya Raksha programme, Swacchata Campaign. Five villages have been adopted through UBA and institution has secured award for rupees one lakh seventy five thousand for village development activities. The major achievements of the institution are significant number of STSH projects secured by UG students. Research funds have been secured by the faculties and students. ROTP and CME conducted by AYUSH for teachers all around India. Conduct of simulation reading for participants from neighbouring institution. Hundred percentage results in UG and PG the students placed in reputed institution.

PURPOSE / SCOPE:

- I. Facilitating Inter disciplinary Research activities
- II. Student extension programme for Research
- III. Training on Faculty Professional development and faculty exchange.
- IV. Joint Scientific sessions, Seminars and Conferences.
- V. Joint publications between the institutions.

Confidentiality and IPR-Protection:

Both parties hereunder agree that, any information disclosed by one party to the other shall be maintained as proprietary confidential information and will be disclosed only to the authorities as required in the relevant statutory regulations and to those persons in the recipient party's organization that has a need to know for purposes authorized by the relevant agreement. All such proprietary confidential information will be kept in confidence and the party receiving such information agrees not to disclose it/them to any other person or persons outside the organization or any unauthorized person or persons except to the organization authorized by either of the parties hereunder on need to know the basis for the execution of the work.

The obligations that are created under this MoU on either party as well as through subsequent relevant agreements on either party shall be duly discharged during the term of the MoU and agreement and after their expiry/termination.

Both parties shall not file any application for seeking intellectual property rights (IPR) in its own name or in the name of its associates or any other person(s) on any matter relating to the collaborative research results developed under this MoU. However, they can seek intellectual property rights in joint names of the parties as mutually agreed, on case to case basis.

Intellectual property generated during the activities under the MoU shall be shared jointly. The extent of ownership shall be decided mutually depending upon the relative intellectual inputs made by the parties.

The expenditure incurred and to be incurred for the maintenance of IPR shall be borne by each party equally or in proportion to the extent of ownership as may be decided by the Steering Committee.

Publications:

Publications, if any, in respect of the activity under this MoU shall be in the names of involved personnel from both the parties. In all publications (papers, reports, etc.,) it will be duly acknowledged that the work has been carried out by VMRF(DU) and Sarada Krishna Homoeopathic Medical College under this MoU between the parties.

Duration:

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be valid for a period of Five years from the date of signing of the same and thereafter can be renewed for further periods subject to such other terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

Termination:

Notwithstanding the above clause, this MOU may be terminated by either party by giving three months prior notice in writing to the other party. Either of the parties shall honor within a mutually agreed period, the outstanding commitments, if any, as on the date of termination.

Notices:

All notices and other communications required to be served on Sarada Krishna Homoeopathic Medical College under the terms of this MoU, shall be considered to be duly served, if the same is delivered at or posted by email or registered mail to the Sarada Krishna Homoeopathic Medical College. Similarly, any notice to be given to the VMRF (DU) shall be considered as duly served, if the same is delivered at or posted by email to Registrar, VMRF(DU).

Arbitration:

In the event of any dispute or difference arises between the parties hereto, such differences shall be resolved amicably by mutual consultation. Where, it could not be resolved so, then it shall be referred to arbitration involving of two Arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party to the dispute and in case of difference of opinion between the said two Arbitrators, then to a third umpire to be appointed by the said two Arbitrators. The decision of the said Arbitrators or Umpire as the case may be shall be final and binding on both parties. The venue of arbitration shall be at such place as may be fixed by the arbitrators or umpire as the case may be and the arbitration proceeding shall be in English and held as provided under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

Jurisdiction:

All legal disputes shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of the courts at Salem in the State of Tamil Nadu only.



Modification:

No modification to this MoU shall be binding unless made in writing and signed by both parties.

Force Majeure:


Any of the parties hereto shall not be released from its obligations for any reason except for force majeure such as war, strike, fire, acts of God or other causes beyond control of the parties.




