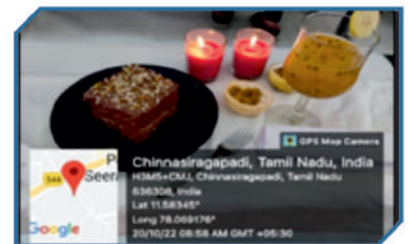
Mehendi Competition

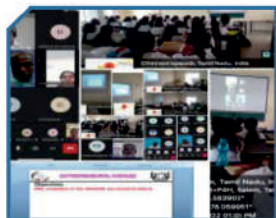

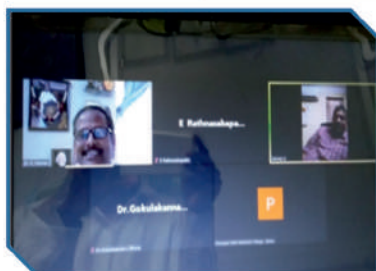

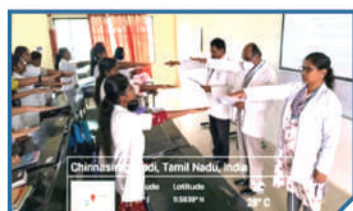
