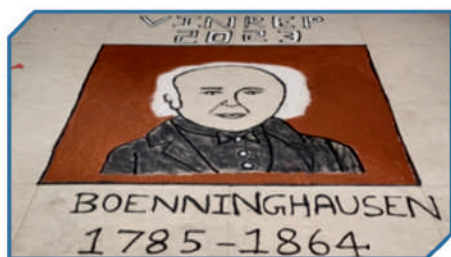

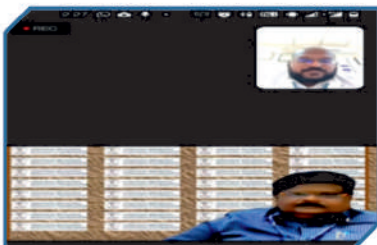


IQAC

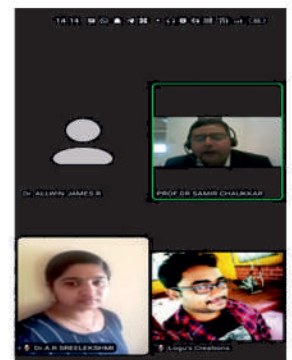


IQAC - WEBINAR PROGRAM
