

ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR THE 38TH BATCH CRRI

As part of the internship curriculum, the Induction Training and Orientation Program for the 38th batch of CRRI (Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship) was conducted from June 1, 2024, to June 11, 2024. The program commenced with a prayer song and the lighting of the traditional lamp. Dr. E. Rathnasabapathi, our Principal and Medical Superintendent, delivered an inspiring speech to the interns.

During the Induction Training Program, Dr. A. Palyu Praveen Raj, (Medical Officer), provided insights into hospital protocols, NABH (National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers) policies, and procedures related to patient care. The curriculum activities for the internship training program were also discussed.

The NABH Hospital Infection Committee members, Dr. K. Radha (Professor & HOD, Department of Pathology and Microbiology) and Dr. S. Karthik (Assistant Professor, Department of Physiology and Biochemistry), conducted training sessions on Biomedical waste management, Needle Stick injury prevention, and hand hygiene. Discussions included the proper segregation and disposal of biomedical waste using color-coded bags and containers. Needle Stick injury awareness and adherence to WHO guidelines for hand hygiene were emphasized.

Dr. Shilpa Prasad (Assistant Professor), a member of the NABH Management of Medication committee, discussed the importance of legible medication orders, hospital formulary, and adverse drug effects.
