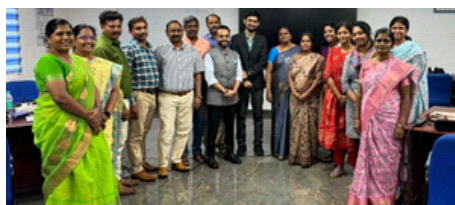


FACULTY PARTICIPATION

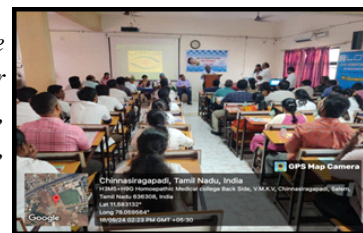


CME

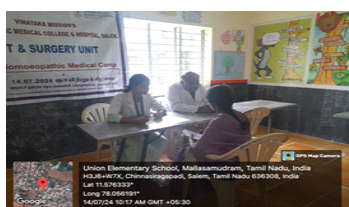

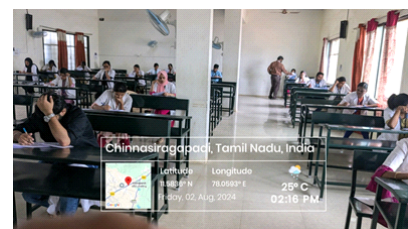

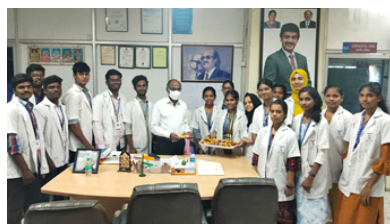
CELEBRATION

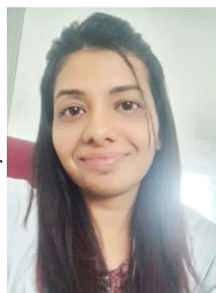
