

WIERLAS, KSMEC Trust which is a Charitable Trust established by virtue of a Deed of Trust dated 09-12-81 of Ng.493 has been engaged in the field of Education, running and maintaining several Educational Institutions and colleges as part & parcel of the Trust, including 1) VINAYAKA HISSICNS SANKAPACIARIYAN DEDTAL COLLECT . 21 VINAVAILA PISSICUS HOMEOPATHY PERICAL COLLECTION

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3) VERAYMEN PICCICLE APPAPEORIA COLLEGE OF NURSING - all the three being situated at SALER (hereinafter referred to as Affiliating Colleges):

MIEREAS, the said KSMEC TRUST has approached the University Grants Commission of the Government of India at New Dolhi (hereinafter called the UGC) to confer the status of a Deemed to be a :NIVERSITY to a Trust to be sponsored by it and to be named as "VINAYAKA MISSION'S RESEARCH FOUNDATION "which will be given all the belonging of these effiliating run the courses of studies in those colleges;

Martens, to the with the rules and regulations University Grants Commission, the Trustees of the KSMEC TRUST have resolved to establish the said " VINAYAKA MISSIONS RESEARCH FOUNDATION" through this "Does of Trust" and have authorised SHRI: A.SHANMUGASUNDARAM, the Managing Trustee to execute this instrument on behalf of the KSPEC TRUST by effectively,

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to the newly created trust with immediate effect whereas in pursuage of the minor intention, I, as the Managing Trustee of the raid Koled Thirth have transferred all the Assets of the Vinayaka Mission's Sankarachariar Dental college, Vinayaka Mission's Annapoorna College of Mursing and Vinayaka Mission's Homeopathy Medical college by this Deed to Vinayaka Mission's RESEARCH FOUNDATION and this is with effect from today.

2 EAME AND REGISTRATION:

The trust together with all the belongings of the affiliating colleges transferred to it under this document shall be known as "VUMAYAMA HISSION'S RESEARCH FOUNDATION" (hereinafter reffered to as the "FC(NDATION") It shall come into existence with effect from today.

3 OFFICE:

The remistered office of the Foundation shall be situated at No.44.A. Second Agraharam, Salem-636 001 with an option to the Trustee to change the office of the Trust whenever they decide to do so subject to the previous approval of all authorities, as required under law.

4 CBJECTIVES

The Chjectives for which the Foundation is established are:-

- 4.1 To support, promote and undertake the advancement of education leading up to and including under-Graduate, Post-Graduate and Dectoral and Post-Doctoral Courses in Arts, Science, Commerce, Law, Engineering, Medicine, Pharmacy, Dentistry Hursing, Homeopethy, Janagement, languages and Fine Arts, Architecture and such other subjects as the Trustee may doem fit.
- 4.2. To provide for research and for the advancement of and dissemination of knowledge,
- 4.3. To do all such other acts and things as may be necessary or desirable to further the objects of the Foundation.

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POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE POUNDATION !!

To carry out the above objects and for the management and projection of the Foundation, the Foundation shall have the Following powers:

- 5.1 to establish courses of study and Research and to provide Instruction in such branches of study as the Foundation deems appropriate for the advancement of learning and dissemination of knowledge in such branches, and to establish new faculties on existing campus at Salem.
- 5.2 To confer degree and to grant Diplomagrand / or Certificates to persons who have satisfactorily completed the approved courses of study and /or Research as may be prescribed and shall have passed the prescribed examinations.
- 5.3 To institute and award visitorships, fellowships, prizes, meduls, stipends and scholarships.

INTERPRETATION OF THE OBJECTS:

The Foundation is established for Public benefit and accordingly the object of the Institute as set-forth above will be interpreted and restricted to mean such objects and purposes as are regarded in law to be a public nature.

FOUNDATION OPEN TO ALL

- 7.1 The Foundation shall be open to all persons of either sex and whatever race, creed, caste or class and no test of condition shall be imposed as to religious belief or . profession in admitting or appointing members, students, Teachers, workers or in any other connection whatsoever.
- 7.2 No capitation for Mill be charged in any form in consideration for admission.
- 7.3 No benefits shall be accepted by the Foundation which in its opinion involves conditions and obligations opposed to the spirit and objects of this.
- INCOME AND PROPERTY OF THE FOUNDATION TO BE APPLIED FOR THE ODJECTS (NLY :

The Income and projectly of the Foundation, however derived shall be applied towards the promotion of the objects thereof as sot-forth in this Ecorandum of Association.

TRANSFERRED BY WAY OF PROFIT: THE STATE OF THE PAID OR

The overall Governance and management of the Foundation will be vested with a Board of Trustees subject to such Rules/Articles/Bye-laws as may be framed by the Board of Trustees from time to time, subject to the legal provisions in this regard. The Board of Trustees will be appointed under the provisions of this clause. The day today administration of the offairs of the Foundation including the Educational establishments under its control shall be run by such Donrd of management/committees/Board of studies/Academic Council and such other Authorities as may be formed under the said rules/Articles/bye-laws etc... The Bank accounts of the Institutions under the Foundation may be operated by such office-bearers of the Institution, as may be specified in this respect is the rules and regulations framed by the Trustees.

11.1. FRETINGS OF THE DOARD OF TRUSTEES:

The Board of Trustees shall meet from time to time as and when necessary to transact the business of the trust. There shall however be at-least Four meetings in a calendar fear. The meetings of the Board shall be presided over by the Danaging Trustee and in his absence any member chosen at the meeting. The Board shall prescribe the procedure to be adopted in the matter of convening the meeting, such as period of meeting, the venue etc.

- 12.c.To purchase, take or lease on in exchange or otherwise acquire deal with, take possession, custody or control of any movable or immovable property which may be deemed necessary, expedient or desirable for any of the objects of the trust

NOW THIS DEED OF AMENDMENT WITNESSETH AS UNDER:-

In the Deed of Trust dated 4th December, 1996 evidending the establishment of the Trust known as VINAYAKA MISSIONS RESEARCH FOUNDATION, registered as Document Number: 187 of 1996 by the Joint Sub Registrar No.3 of Salem, between clauses 14 and 15, the following shall be added as Clause No.14-A with immediate effect;
