ORDER:

In February 1988, the Thirumuruga Kirupananda Variyar
Thavathiru Sundara Swamigal Medical Educational & Charitable
Trust applied to the Council for permission to start a College
by name Vinayaka Mission Homoeo Medical College at Salem. The
application was considered in an Extra-ordinary Meeting of the
Council held on 20th June, 1988. An Inspection Committee was
constituted consisting of five Members under the Chairmanship
of Dr. S.P. Koppikar to inspect the proposed College and
submit a report.

The Committee with the Registrar of the Council con-
ducted the inspection on 14-7-88 and 15-7-88. The Committee made
an on the spot study, scrutinised documents of the lands owned by
the Trust and checked up its financial soundness.

The Trust owns total of about 150 acres of lands in two
blocks in Salem, one at the foot of Shevroys Hills and the other
in the Salem-Coimbatore National Highway. They are already running
following full fledged recognised Institutions:

1. Vinayaka Missions Sankarachariar Dental College
2. Vinayaka Missions Kirupananda Variyar Engineering College
3. Vinayaka Missions College of Pharmacy
4. Vinayaka Missions Kirupananda Variyar Sundara
Swamigal Polytechnic
5. Vinayaka Mission I.T.I.

Besides, the Trust runs a 100 bed hospital with an
operation theatre in the heart of the Salem Town.

Financial worthiness of the Trust is very sound.
Audited statement of the Trust was scrutinised. The Chairman of
the Trust is willing to implement all the requirements prescribed
by the Central Council of Homoeopathy. The trust has already

constructed three-storeyed block in the lands at the foot of Shevroys Hills where the Dental and Pharmacy Courses are conducted. There are well equipped departments of Physiology, Pathology, Microbiology, Anatomy etc.

Polytechnic School and the Engineering College are situated in the lands on Salem-Coimbatore National Highway which is about 12 km. from Salem Town.

Chairman of the Inspecting Committee pointed out that according to norms of the Central Council that the Homoeopathy College should have separate building with an attached Hospital. The Chairman of the Trust agreed to this proposal and has given an agreement to this effect in a stamped paper signed by a notary public. An extent of 10.23 acres of land in the Salem-Coimbatore National Highway has been earmarked for the College. He has given a site sketch and a xerox copy of the land documents where the proposed College is to be situated.

The Committee was fully satisfied with the working of the Trust and feel that it would be a prestige to grant permission to such an Organisation to conduct B.H.M.S. Course. Further, Salem is situated in Centre of Tamilnadu where a College is needed.

In the circumstances, the Committee recommended for the Provisional affiliation to the Vinayaka Missions Homoeopathy Medical College to be started by the Trust under Section 22 of the Tamilnadu Homoeopathy System of Medicine and Practitioners of Homoeopathy Act 1971.


Report of the Inspection Committee was placed before the Council in its General Body Meeting held on 9-8-88. The Council accepted the report of the Committee and resolved unanimously that provisional affiliation may be granted to the proposed College with immediate effect after obtaining the following:

- a) Security Deposit of Rs.5/- lakhs (G.O. Ms.No.9 IM&H Dept., dated 7-2-85) in one payment or in instalments, the first instalment being Rs.2/- lakhs as per norms prescribed by the Council which is to be deposited in favour of Trust and the Registrar, Tamilnadu Homoeopathy Council in a Nationalised Bank (~~State Bank of India, Triplicane Branch, Madras-5~~) and the F.D.R. with the Council as Security
- b) Provisional affiliation of Rs.5,000/- by D.D. in favour of the Registrar, Tamilnadu Homoeopathy Council, Madras-5 to the Council
- c) The extent of 10.23 acres of land earmarked for the proposed College shall be confirmed by a Registered Deed in stamp paper, so that the identity of this Institution is on permanent basis.

The Chairman of the Trust who was addressed in the matter has fulfilled all the above conditions and furnished a report.

In exercise of the powers conferred under Sec.22(1) of the Tamilnadu Homoeopathy System of Medicine & Practitioners of Homoeopathy Act 1971 (Act 5 of 1972), the Council is pleased to grant provisional affiliation to the Vinayaka Mission Homoeopathy Medical College proposed to be started at Salem by the Thirumuruga Kirupananda Variyar Medical Educational & Charitable Trust subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) The Trust shall remit Rs.5/- lakhs to the Council in instalments as prescribed in the norms
- 2) The proposed College Building, Hospital and Hostels shall be completed within a year from the date of starting
- 3) Norms in regard to staff, equipments, accommodation, hospital etc. prescribed by the Central Council of Homoeopathy (minimum standards of education) Regulations, 1983 shall be strictly followed
- 4) Syllabus prescribed by the Central Council shall be followed
- 5) Total number of admission of students shall be restricted to 60 for the first year, strictly following the rule of 1 student per one bed of the Hospital. The hospital must be planned as a hundred bedded one, with a view to increase the number of admissions
- 6) Examinations will be conducted by the Council. If due to any reason the Council is not in a position to conduct the examinations, it shall be the duty of the College to seek affiliation to a University like the M.G.R. Medical University. The Council will do its best help in the matter
- 7) There should be one Council Member nominated by the Council in the Selection Committee for the selection of candidates for the first year
- 8) Any Council Member who comes to inspect the College and the concerned records on the authorisation of the Council shall be extended all facilities to carry out his inspection
- 9) Fees shall be collected as per the University norms and similar to the Govt. Homoeopathy College in Tamil Nadu
- 10) As far as possible, full time staff should be appointed for all subjects
- 11) 60 students can be admitted according to the Management quota. 5 students out of 60 will be sponsored by the Council whether on merit basis or for Homoeopathy Doctor's children.
